Multidisciplinary Introduction to Research (EDF 2910) 1 credit

Students will develop transferrable skills in primary literature search and analysis and refine their interests through a guest researcher series to explore research through the lens of multiple disciplines. As groups, students will put these skills into practice by leading a journal club-style discussion of their research paper analysis.
